Valuations offer reasonable risk-reward

Quick Pointers

AUM & NII sluggish, asset quality bettering

Revenue growth weakens as market challenges in the nature of funding pressures, need for excess liquidity on balance sheet and continued lower disbursals proved as a dampener in Q4FY19. PAT at Rs 7.5bn grew 18% QoQ ahead of estimates on the back of one-offs – (i) subsidiary (Shriram Automall) stake sale gains at Rs 1075mn (ii) tax adjustments of Rs 1098mn and (iii) 15% QoQ decline in provisions driven by lower incremental ECL provisions. While Management stands confident of the used CV financing demand catching up on back of BSVI shift and rural penetration aiding growth, we continue to incorporate CV downcycle headwinds and foresee AUM growing at 15% YoY for FY20, 16% for FY21E, margin compression (7.6% in FY20, 7.4% in FY21) denting RoAs to 2.4%, RoEs to 16% by FY21E. PE exits and group level restructuring refer our recent note should remain an overhang on the stock. As trough valuations adequately price-in current apprehensions, we reiterate BUY, however, foresee multiple shrinking hence fine-tune our price target to Rs 1,481 (earlier Rs 1,568) valuing SHTF at 1.8x Mar-21 ABV (earlier 2.0x).

Decent AUM traction: Maintaining balance sheet liquidity takes precedence over growth and hence AUM witnessed weak 8.5% growth YoY. While H1FY20 is expected to be somber, Management stands confident of better growth outlook (18%+) in H2FY20 driven by BSVI shift and improved rural demand. Our AUM estimates at 15% growth YoY for FY20,16% FY21E incorporates the tepid near term CV industry outlook.

Bettering asset quality to offset NIM compression: Bettering asset quality is a good sign and Q4FY19 observed Gross Stage 3 assets declining 2% QoQ to Rs88.9bn. While Management aims to maintain 2% credit costs, the same should compensate NIM compression in turn boosting RoA. Persistent market headwinds prompt us to maintain conservative 2.2% credit costs estimates, somber NIMs at 7.4-7.6% despite pricing power and therefore expect 2.4% RoAs over FY20-21E. Lower multiple of 1.3x PABV FY21E that factors-in market apprehensions offers reasonable risk-reward, we stay positive on the used CV finance business and SHTF's dominance in the market, reiterate BUY.

Key Concall takeaways: Political upheavals and real estate/infrastructure slowdown impacted demand scenario over past 6 months. Rural demand intact and normal monsoon should only help. Management expects disbursements growth at 20%, AUM 18-20% YoY and NIMs at ~7.2%. Rural focus to aid yields and growth expansion ahead. SHTF expects to maintain liquidity at Rs 80bn in FY20 given the market challenges. To support growth, SHTF aims to raise Rs 50bn through NCD borrowings, securitization and expects cost pressures transmission. ALM remains healthy with positive cash-flows across all buckets. Improved recoveries on the back of improvising operator cash flows aided bettering asset quality for Q4FY19). SHTF reported write-off of Rs8.1bn (for Q4FY19 and Rs 23.5bn for FY19.

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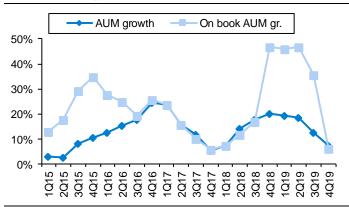

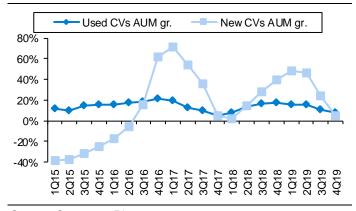
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Exhibit 2: AUM growth tepid...



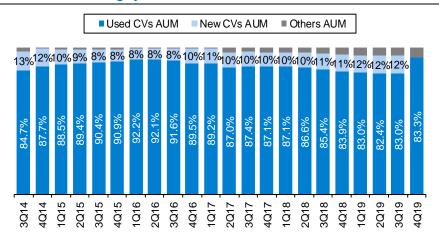

Exhibit 3: ...contributed from used CVs



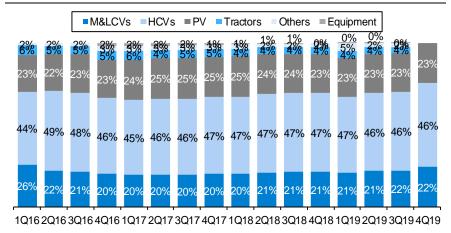

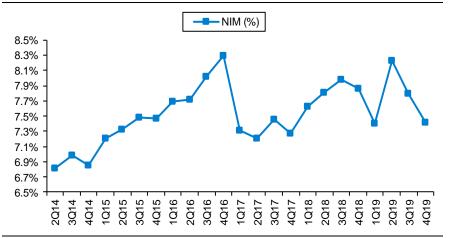
Exhibit 5: Other loans saw uptick in Q4FY19 over CV loans

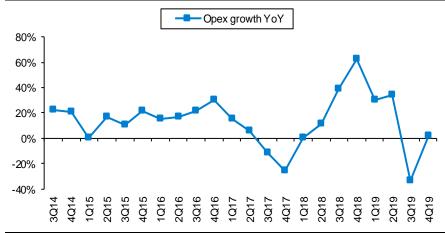
Exhibit 6: Margins decline as costs escalate

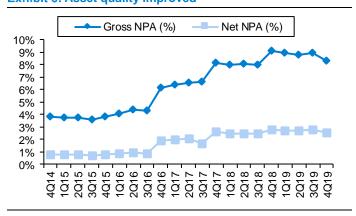
Company's cost-income still continues to be lower despite investing into network expansion and penetration

Exhibit 7: Opex climbed...



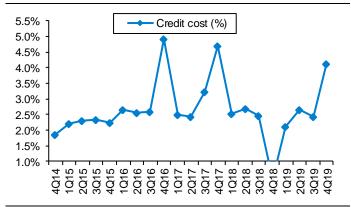
