FMCG-others segment sustains double-digit revenue growth

Result Highlights of Q2FY22:

- Total revenue grew by 12.9% YOY (+4.2% QoQ) to INR 148,444 Mn which was above our estimates (est. INR 141,996 Mn)
- EBITDA margin expanded 33 bps YoY (+260 bps QoQ) to 33.8% while absolute EBITDA grew by 14% YoY (+12.9% QoQ) to INR 50,176 Mn
- EBIT grew by 15% YoY (14.1% QoQ) to INR 45,959 Mn.
- Adj PAT grew by 10.3% YoY (13.3% QoQ) to INR 37,138 Mn, PAT margin contracted by 60 bps YoY (+201 bps QoQ) to 25%.

Revenue witnessed double-digit growth as demand surges

ITC's revenue during the Q2FY22 stood at INR 148,444 Mn (+12.9% YOY / +4.2% QoQ). The growth was driven by strong recovery across all the operating segments including Cigarettes (+10.5% YOY). Cigarettes volume witnessed smart recovery with exit volumes near pre-covid levels. The FMCG - Other's performance was led by snacks, confectionery, and beverages; the segment delivered resilient performance growing on a high base of Q2FY21. ITC witnessed sharp rebound in out of home consumption on the back of improved mobility even as at home consumption moderates. ITC is focusing on expansion of distribution network and innovation which will help the company to sustain its growth trajectory in near to medium term. The pandemic impacted Hotels segment witnessed progressive recovery, its revenue grew by 254.5% YOY. For H1FY22, revenue stood at INR 290,851 Mn (23.1% YOY). Leisure destinations continued to perform well while business travel gathered momentum. Faster recovery in the segment was driven by increased occupancy rate (3x of Q2FY21).

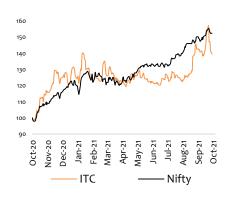
Margin expansion in FMCG segment, Hotels EBITDA turns positive

ITC also performed well at the operating level as compared to the last year. EBITDA margin expanded by 33 bps YoY / 260 bps QoQ to 33.8%, while absolute EBITDA grew by 14% YoY / 12.9% QoQ to INR 50,176 Mn due to better product mix and gradual signs of recovery. For H1FY22, EBITDA stood at INR 94,613 Mn (+28.8% YoY), with OPM at 32.5% (+143 bps YoY) due to recovery in demand and better product mix. The FMCG – Other's segment EBITDA stood at INR 4,030 Mn (+35% QoQ and +82% over Q2FY20), while the segment EBITDA margins sustained at 10% in spite of unprecedented commodity inflation. Q2FY22 Hotels segment EBITDA turns positive (INR +1,340 Mn) as compared to the EBITDA in Q1FY21. Overall, PAT grew by 10.3% YoY to INR 37,138 Mn, with NPM at 25% (-60 bps YoY) due to higher tax expenses. For H1FY22, PAT stood INR 69,902 Mn (+18.9% YoY), with NPM at 24% (-85 bps YoY).

Multiple initiatives undertaken to successfully counter the COVID-19 impact

The FMCG Businesses continue to leverage cutting-edge digital technologies including Industry 4.0, Advanced Analytics, Big Data and industrial Internet of Things (IoT) to enhance productivity, drive efficiency and reduce costs. These initiatives encompass drawing actionable insights for sharp-focused interventions, synchronized planning & forecasting, next generation agile supply chain, smart manufacturing & sourcing, deepening connect with retailers and smart demand capture & fulfilment. 'ITC e-store', the Company's exclusive D2C platform is now operational in 15 cities. Powered by state-of-the-art digital technologies and a robust fulfilment infrastructure, the platform offers consumers on-demand access to a wide range of the Company's FMCG products across 45+ categories and over 850 products under one roof. Consumer response has been excellent.

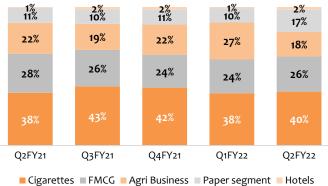
(i) Modern Trade sales grew strongly, both y-o-y (favorable base) and sequentially on the back of improved mobility and store footfalls. (ii) E-Commerce channel posted robust growth on the back of account specific strategies, new product introductions including e-Commerce first brands and customized supply chain solutions; channel salience stood at 7% in H1 – 3x of H1 FY20 level. (iii) 'Aashirvaad' Atta consolidated its leadership position in the branded atta industry; forayed into the valueadded adjacent vermicelli category, leveraging the strong equity of the Aashirvaad brand. (iv) The FMCG Businesses continue to leverage alternate and on-thego channels to enhance product accessibility. Recent interventions include strategic partnerships with large food service outlet chains, covering a range of brands including 'B Natural', 'Sunfeast', 'Kitchens of India', etc. (v) Cigarette's segment witnessed Faster recovery in volumes vs. first wave; exit volumes near pre-Covid levels. (vi) Recent launches include differentiated offerings anchored on the vectors of filters, variants and packaging formats- Classic Connect, Gold Flake Neo SMART Filter, Gold Flake Kings Mixpod, American Club Smash, Wave Boss and Flake Nova. (vii) With easing of travel restrictions imposed during the second wave, domestic leisure segment and staycations witnessed an uptick during the quarter; Business travel continues to gather momentum. Strong recovery in Occupancy levels; ARRs improve on sequential and y-o-y basis but remain below pre-Covid levels. (viii) Paperboards and Specialty Papers Business witnessed revival of demand across most end-user segments. Publications, Quick Service Restaurants (QSR) and wedding card segments, however, remain relatively subdued. (ix) The Businesses continue to focus on developing sustainable paperboard and packaging solutions for end customers leveraging the expertise of ITC LSTC. (x) Robust growth in External Businesses led by Wheat, Rice, Leaf Tobacco, Aqua and Spices exports. Margin expansion driven by favorable business and customer mix.

Valuation and view: ITC with a diversified operations across non-cyclical sectors, a resilient business model, strong brand leadership position in cigarette business, product innovation track record & premiumization drive is establishing itself as a FMCG major. Despite the ongoing Covid related slowdown, we see recovery signs in recent past and believe the current valuation is attractive for long term investors. Since our last recommendation, the stock price of ITC achieved our target price of INR 228. We value ITC shares using an SOTP (Sum of the parts) approach implying 10.1x EV/EBITDA on FY24E to Cigarette business (earlier 9.2x on FY23E); 18.8x EV/EBITDA on Hotel segment (earlier 16.1x on FY23E); an average 5.5x EV/EBITDA on Agri/Paper business (earlier 5x on FY23E); and 10.2x on EV/Revenue on FMCG segment (earlier 7.8x on FY23E) – we revise our target price to INR 310 per share; an upside of 39% over the CMP. Accordingly, we assign a "BUY" (earlier ACCUMULATE) rating on the shares of ITC Ltd.

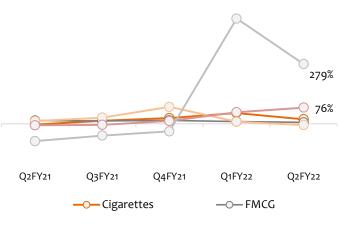








Segment wise Revenue growth YoY (%)
