WABAG secures ADB funded 'Large' DBO order from Melamchi Water Supply Development Board, Government of Nepal

November 20, 2025: VA TECH WABAG ('WABAG'), a leading pure-play water technology Indian Multinational Group, secured a 'Large' repeat order from Melamchi Water Supply Development Board ('MWSDB'), Nepal, towards Design, Build and Operate ('DBO') of a state-of-the-art Sundarijal Water Treatment Plant ('WTP') with a capacity of 255 Million Liter per Day ('MLD') in Kathmandu Valley, funded by the Asian Development Bank ('ADB').

The Engineering, Procurement and Construction ('EPC') scope will be executed over thirty-six (36) months, followed by five (5) years of Operation and Maintenance ('O&M'), underscoring WABAG's lifecycle partnership capabilities.
