Strong capex plans in renewables and distribution business

Summary

- CESC in its investor day presented its Vision 2030. The company intends to double the PAT by then.
- Company has strong capex plans of over Rs. 32,000 crore till FY30, with Rs. 23,000 crore for renewables, Rs. 6,000 crore for distribution and Rs. 3,000 crore for developing a 3GW cell & module manufacturing capacity.
- The growth plan includes pursuing new distribution licenses in UP and other areas and turnaround in Malegaon DF.
- We retain Buy on CESC with an unchanged PT of Rs. 195 on a SOTP basis. Renewable energy capex, new distribution license wins would drive the growth and turnaround of the existing distribution business would further aid the earnings.

Renewable capacity addition: CESC plans to have capacity of 3.2GW by 2029 in its Phase 1 with a capex of Rs. 23,000 crore. Wind capacity to be 1.7GW and solar capacity to be 1.5GW. Out of 3.2GW, 2GW will be for supply to own discoms only. In Phase 2, capacity to be 10GW by 2032. Currently, 1.2GW of capacity is under implementation in Phase 1 with PPA signed and connectivity secured. The focus going forward will be on Hybrid and FDRE bids from SECI/NTPC. Company has secured total connectivity of 3.8GW across high solar/wind potential states. For the renewable capacity, CESC is also developing a 3GW solar cell & module manufacturing plant over the next two years for a capex of Rs. 3,000 crore. This plant will be used for captive purposes only.

Distribution business: The UP state government is privatizing Purvanchal Vidyut Vitaran Nigam Ltd (PUVVNL) and Dakshinchal Vidyut Vitran Nigam Ltd (DVVNL). They have a total customer base of over 17.6 mn, annual revenue potential of Rs. 29,000 crore and annual sales of 55,000MU+ across 5 distribution licenses. Company intends to win few of these licenses and has planned a capex of Rs. 6,000 crore in the distribution business till FY30. The Chandigarh distribution business which was acquired last year will see a Rs. 1,000 crore capex for network improvement, operational reliability and Metering overhaul. The vision involves achieving breakeven in the Malegaon DF over next 3 years by reducing T&D losses (currently 39%). Large scale de-hooking drives and meter installations will be carried out.

Our Call

Valuation - Maintain Buy with an unchanged SoTP-based PT of Rs. 195: CESC will benefit because of the signing of Chandrapur PPA (225 MW) at higher tariffs, renewable energy capacity addition, cell & module plant, new distribution licenses and turnaround of the power distribution businesses. Renewable energy capacity of 1.2 GW/ 3.2 GW is to be commissioned by FY27/29 respectively. The 1.2 GW capacity can generate an annual revenue of Rs. 1,200 crore. Company had also implemented a 5.7% tariff hike in the Kolkata discom for recovery of fuel and power purchase adjustment surcharge which will aid the cash flow. Hence, we maintain Buy on CESC with an unchanged SoTP-based PT of Rs. 195.

Outlook and Valuation

■ Sector Outlook – Power demand to rise and renewable capacity mix to increase

India's power demand is growing more than the GDP growth rate and is expected to clock strong growth in the coming years. The sector is experiencing a fundamental shift towards clean energy, driven by the national target of 500 GW renewable capacity by 2030. The sector sees major opportunities in distribution reforms through RDSS scheme and grid modernization initiatives like smart metering. While thermal power faces challenges from coal costs and environmental regulations, it remains essential for base load. Distribution privatization, renewable energy adoption, and supportive policies create a favorable growth environment. The industry's future hinges on balancing conventional power with renewables while integrating new technologies for grid stability.

■ Company Outlook – Improvement in power demand and turnaround of subsidiaries to improve consolidated earnings

Growth in standalone business with the signing of the Chandrapur PPA, lower losses at distribution franchisees led by lower T&D losses, renewable capacity addition and turnaround of Rajasthan/Malegaon DF are expected to improve the consolidated earnings of CESC over FY2025-FY2027E.

■ Valuation – Maintain Buy with an unchanged SoTP-based PT of Rs. 195

CESC will benefit because of the signing of Chandrapur PPA (225 MW) at higher tariffs, renewable energy capacity addition, cell & module plant, new distribution licenses and turnaround of the power distribution businesses. Renewable energy capacity of 1.2 GW/ 3.2 GW is to be commissioned by FY27/29 respectively. The 1.2 GW capacity can generate an annual revenue of Rs. 1,200 crore. About company

CESC started operations in 1899. The company is a fully integrated power utility company. The company is the sole electricity distributor within 567 sq. km of Kolkata and Howrah and serves 3.6 million consumers (including domestic, industrial, and commercial users). The company owns and operates three thermal power plants with a generation capacity of 1,485 MW for its Kolkata distribution business. Additionally, CESC has independent power plants of Chandrapur (600 MW) and Crescent Power (40 MW). CESC has a distribution license within 335 sq. km of Noida and serves 1.87 lakh consumers. The company has distribution franchisees in three cities of Rajasthan (Kota, Bikaner, and Bharatpur) and one city in Maharashtra (Malegaon). Also, the company recently acquired 100% stake in Chandigarh Power Distribution Ltd. (CPDL). It is the sole distributor of electricity in Chandigarh.

Investment theme

Growth in standalone business with the signing of the Chandrapur PPA, lower losses at distribution franchisees led by lower T&D losses, renewable capacity addition and turnaround of Rajasthan/Malegaon DF are expected to improve the consolidated earnings of CESC over FY2025-FY2027E.

Key Risks
